Nesting sites not identified. No eagle chicks seen, only single adult eagles observed around nest by early July.

2013	?	1?	0	Lake level very high during nesting period. One chick sighting reported late June, however no chicks on lake by July 3. Multiple and variable numbers of loons on lake. Most frequently there appeared to be two pairs on lake. Two Eagle chicks this year.
2014	?	0	0	No nesting activity observed. At least one apparent pair on lake through most of summer. No Eagles nesting this year.
2015	?	0	0	No nesting activity observed. At least one apparent pair seen on lake. Eagle nesting with one chick.

2018	4	0	0	Loons first seen on lake 5 May (Lake partially ice covered). Nesting site on North state island 9 June. Second nesting pair identified in Baker Bay. After heavy rain on 6/15, Baker bay nest inundated and abandoned. Nests examined after inundated Two eggs in nest. After continued rains and increased lake levels, by 6/18 the nest on North state island also inundated and abandoned. Two eggs in nest (total of 4 eggs lost). Eagle nest in new site on Virgin Island. Two chicks observed.
2019	2 observed by telescope	0	0	Loon nesting on South state island. Second pair seen in South part of Lynx Lake mid June, no apparent nesting activity identified. Occasional separate loon seen on lake. Nest abandoned 5 July with one egg in nest, second egg not accounted. Eagle nest with two chicks.
